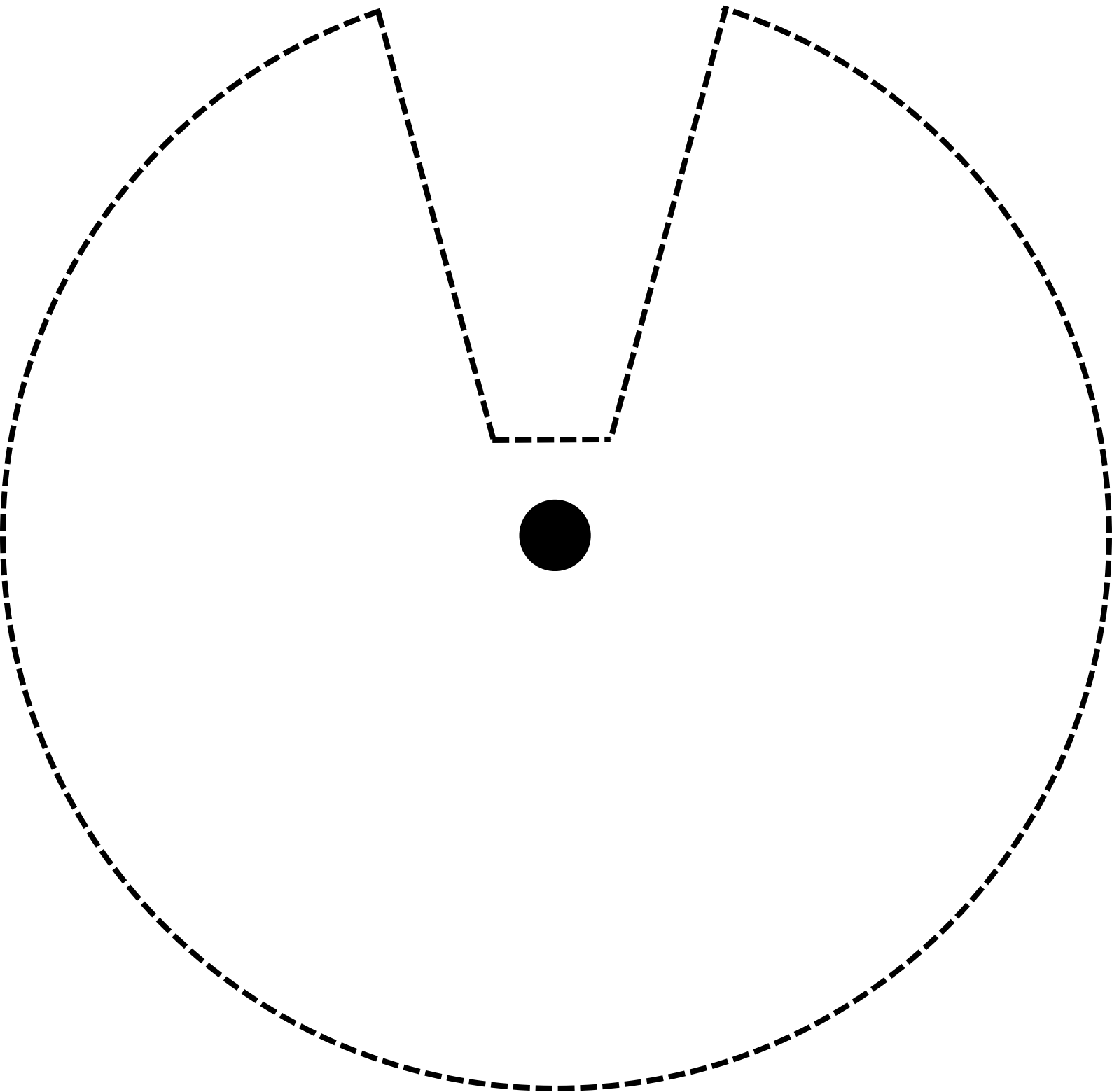

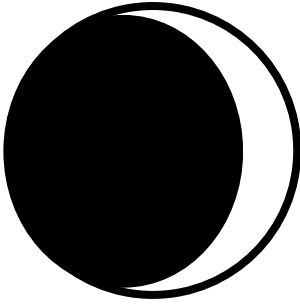


Cut around the lines and punch a hole in the centre

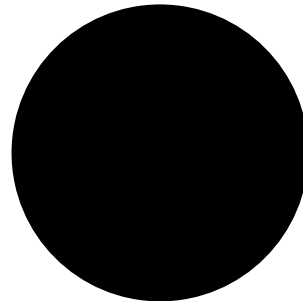
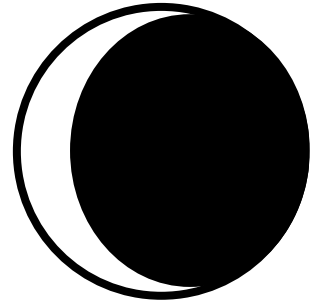

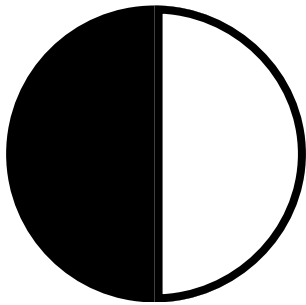

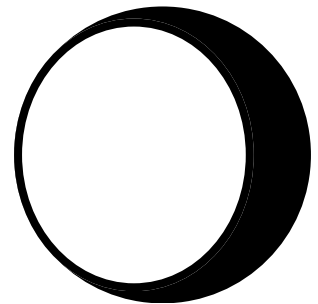
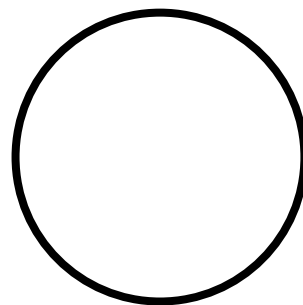

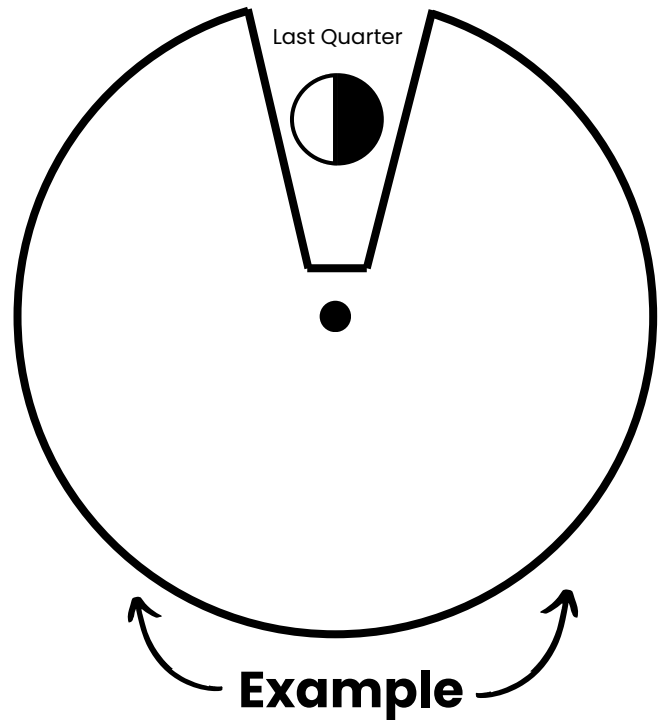

Let's Get Making!

You will need

- Printed out template
- Paper plate
- Yellow marker
- Paper fastener
- Scissors
- Glue



Step By Step

Step 1: Colour the Moon Phases.

Colour in all the white areas of each moon using a yellow marker.

Step 2: Cut Out the Moons

Carefully cut out each moon phase and its label

Step 3: Attach the Moons to the Paper Plate

Glue the moon phases around the edge of the paper plate in the correct order.

Place the labels above the correct moon phase.

Step 4: Prepare the Spinner

Cut around the dashed line of the spinner template. Punch a hole in the centre dot of the spinner.

Step 5: Assemble the Tracker

Place the spinner on top of the paper plate.

Line up the centre holes.

Push the paper fastener through both holes and fasten it at the back.

Step 6: Use Your Moon Tracker

Turn the spinner to reveal one moon phase at a time.
